FIRST STEAMWORKSSM Overview

Invites two adventurers' clubs in an era where steam power reigns, to prepare their airship for a long distance race. Each three-team alliance prepares in three ways:

- 1. Build steam pressure.
- 2. Start rotors.
- 3. Prepare for flight.

Each match beings with a 15 second autonomous period in which robots operate only on pre-programmed instructions. During the remaining 2 minutes and 15 seconds of the match, the teleoperated period, student drivers control robots.
